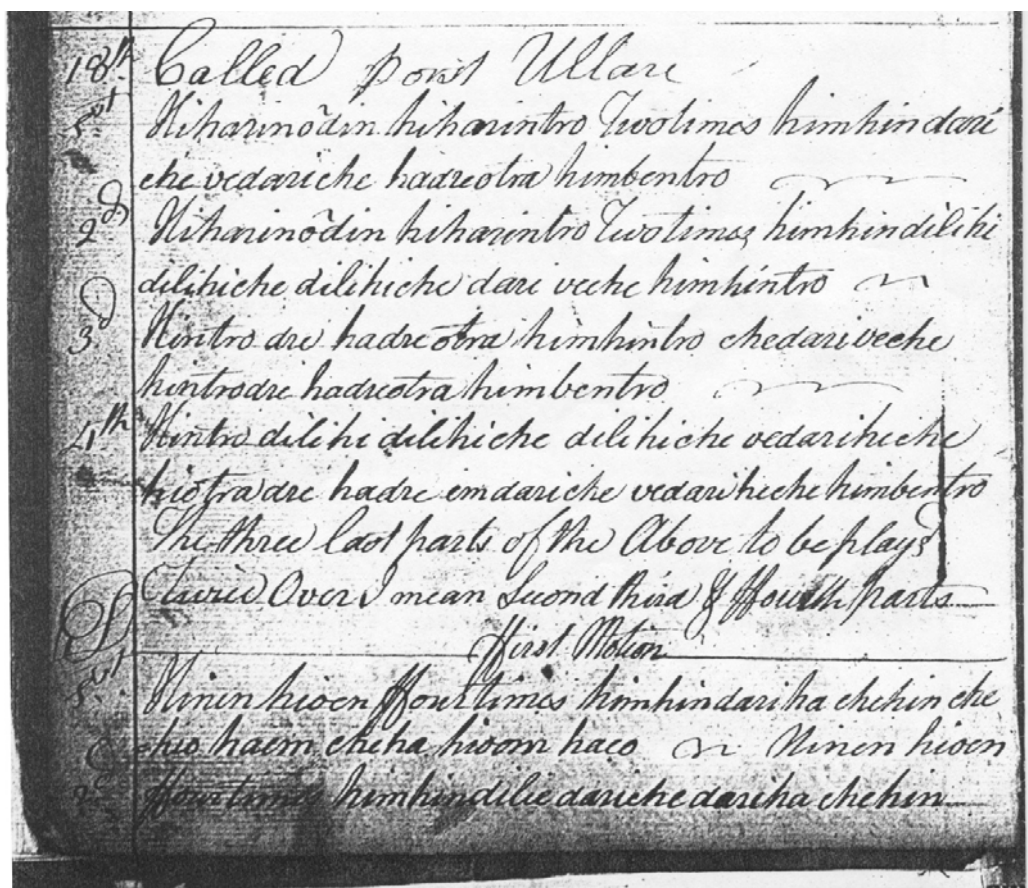


## Porst Ullare

There is a single manuscript source for this tune:

Colin Campbell's "Nether Lorn Canntaireachd," i, 41-3.
